SUMMER 2023 STUDENT GUIDE

A LEVEL EXAMINATIONS AND RESIT OPPORTUNITIES

We understand that students' learning has been disrupted in recent years. We will continue to support you if you are re-sitting your A Levels in 2023.

Some students will only need to take A2 units to achieve an A Level in 2023.

YOU WILL ONLY NEED TO TAKE A2 UNITS TO ACHIEVE AN A LEVEL IN 2023 IF:

- you were awarded an A Level in the same specification in summer 2022 and are resitting in summer 2023 (this can include a U), or
- you were awarded an AS qualification in the same specification in summer 2020 (Centre Assessed Grade) or summer 2021 (Centre Determined Grade) and have deferred your A Levels until summer 2023, or
- you were awarded an A Level qualification in the same specification in summer 2020 (Centre Assessed Grade) or summer 2021 (Centre Determined Grade) and wish to resit in summer 2023, or
- you completed AS units in 2019 or earlier and therefore have banked units to carry forward. This is subject to the resit rules outlined in our <u>Guide to</u> <u>resits.</u>

YOU WILL NEED TO TAKE ALL AS AND A2 UNITS IN 2023 (OR HAVE BANKED UNITS TO CARRY FORWARD) IF:

- you did not cash-in your A Level units in summer 2022, or
- you were not awarded an AS qualification in the same specification in summer 2020 or summer 2021 (this can include a U), or
- you are taking both AS and A Level units for the first time (e.g. completing an A Level in one year).

IF YOU SAT AS UNITS IN 2022, THE RESULTS WILL CONTRIBUTE TO YOUR A LEVEL RESULTS IN 2023

If you are resitting in summer 2023, please talk to staff at your school or college to ensure that you are covering the correct units.
